NOTIFICATION

This is for general information of all the Heads of the Teaching Departments / Director in-charge of the Study Centres and Institute, Dibrugarh University, that the following procedure may be followed for streamlining the hostel admission process in the interest of the students to be admitted to the different courses for the session 2015-2016.

- 1. The Department(s) / Centre (s) / Institute will inform the students that hostel admission shall be completed on the very day of admission to their respective Departments/ Centres. (i.e. 29.07.2015, 30.07.2015, 31.07.2015, 03.08.2015, 04.08.2015 and 07.08.2015)
- 2. It may also be noted that, the Department (s) / Centre (s) / Institute which have already completed their admission process may forward the names of eligible students for hostel admission purely on merit basis as per statutory norms (as mentioned under point 4 below) to the office of the undersigned on or before **30.07.2015**.
- 3. The students after allotment of hostel seats shall have to occupy the same on or before 09.08.2015. Otherwise their seats shall automatically stand cancelled, and further requests shall not be entertained.
- 4. The Head of the Department (s) / Director (s) of Study Centres / Institute are hereby requested to select students (i.e. those who have applied for hostel admission) purely on merit basis and as per statutory reservation norms –

a. SC : 7%
b. ST(P) : 10%
c. ST (H) : 5%
d. OBC/MOBC : 15%
e. PH : 3%

The Head of the Department (s)/Director (s) of Study Centres / Institute may take note of the details of allotment of hostel seats along with distribution of the same in Boys' and Girls' hostels (as per vacancy in the hostels) enclosed herewith in accordance with the decision of the Hostel Admission Committee meeting held on **23.07.2015.**

5. The Department (s) /Centre (s) / Institute will notify that the applicants selected for admission to the hostels shall have to deposit a fee of Rs. 2,900/- per annum (for hostel admission) on the day of their Departmental admission itself and allottee shall occupy their seats immediately, failing which their seats shall automatically be treated as cancelled (as mentioned in point 3).
