IMPORTANT NOTICE

- 1. All the matches shall be played for one day limited over (35 over to be bowled by each side).
- 2. All the matches shall be played on the basis of experimental laws of BCCI and AIU, New Delhi which will be in force in all 1st class matches in India for the session 2014-15
- 3. Matches as far as practicable should be started from 9.00 A.M. daily.
- 4. Qualified Umpires of ACA should be appointed. In case of non availability of qualified Umpires, the host team may arrange umpires mutually in consultation with the visiting team.
- 5. No protest against the decision of the umpires shall be entertained under any circumstances.
- 6. If both the teams scored equal runs, the winner shall be decided on the basis of Run Rates/Fall of Wickets. Minimum 15 over shall be bowled in case of above.
- 7. One Bowler shall bowl maximum 7 over in an innings and which shall be proportionately reduced in case of playing time and over are reduced.
- 8. If there is no play or not a single ball is bowl due to natural calamity/inclement weather condition or any other compelling reasons, the winner shall be decided by spin of coin.
