2. M.Phil in Assamese, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, Education, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Statistics and Sociology.

Eligibility: Post-graduate with minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade point.

 - *In case of Ph.D. Pre-registration Course Work in Engineering (Civil, Electrical and Mechanical), the filled-in Application Forms along with the self attested requisite testimonials to be submitted at the Office of the Dibrugarh University Institute of Engineering and Technology (DUIET) or at the Office of the Jorhat Engineering College, Jorhat within the stipulated date mentioned as above.
- The filled in Application Forms for Admission to the Post Graduate Programmes in Bodo Language, Mising Language and Deori Language shall have to be submitted at the Centre for Studies in Languages, Dibrugarh University.

The filled in Application Forms shall have to be accompanied by a Fee Deposit Bank Receipt of Rs,300/- of Punjab National Bank (PNB) or State Bank of India (SBI), which may be tendered through any of their branches. The prescribed PNB and SBI Bank Challan for fee deposit are available along with this notification.

POST GRADUATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAMMES IN BODO, MISING AND DEORI LANGUAGES

The Bodos, Misings and Deoris Languages

The Bodos, Misings and Deoris are the major plains tribal communities living in the various districts of Assam and other states of North East India. As the distinct ethnic tribal groups, the Bodos, Misings as well as the Deoris have their own mode of livelihood, culture, religion, institutions, festivals, rituals, taboos and language, which portrays the unique features of the Communities as the major tribal population groups of the Country.

The Bodo, Mising and Deori Languages are the subbranches of the Tibeto-Burman branch of the Tibeto-Chinese Language family. These languages have its own distinctive features with its large number of oral and written literature decorated by a huge granary of yet to be explored vocabularies, phrases and idioms, etc.

Dibrugarh University has decided to introduce the Bodo, Mising and Deori Language as the Post Graduate Certificate Programmes on certain broad perspectives. First, as a language spoken by a large community of Assam, learning the language academically is important to understand their ways of life, to study the various sociocultural, economic and other dimensions of the community and more importantly to assimilate with them. Secondly, it is observed that in case of bi-lingual speakers, the dominant language plays a hegemonic role and gradually the primary language of the Community losses self-



sustenance and self-confidence. Recognition of a language as an independent discipline of study may help in discouraging such symptoms in future.

The Programmes

The Post Graduate Certificate Programmes in Bodo, Mising and Deori Language intends to establish an independent discipline of Studies under the Centre for Studies in Languages, Dibrugarh University. The Programme has three principal objectives-

- a) To introduce these Languages as a language to learn, speak and write,
- To study the Language from the linguistic points of view.
- To develop the Communicative Skill through these Languages to understand the various aspects of society.

The Course Structure

The Post Graduate Certificate Programmes in Bodo, Mising and Deori Language contains 12 credits equally distributed in three Courses. The Course I shall endeavor to make learners understand the phonological and lexical typology of the concerned Language. The Course II shall attempt to make verbal and communicative exercise through grammatical interpretations. The Course III is designed to develop communicative skill, translation skill, skill of creative writings in the concerned Language.

Eligibility for Admission

Graduate in any discipline shall be eligible for admission into the Post Graduate Certificate Programme sin Bodo, Mising and Deori Language. The intending applicants may submit a brief write up on his/ her objectives for choosing the subject for study, which



may help the course teachers to provide his/ her instruction as per the learner's aspirations.

Intake

Intake capacity for each batch shall be of 30.

Academic Session

The Programmes shall be conducted during every Even Semester starting from January to June.
