- (a) The Departments/ Centres of Studies concerned shall specify the details of the Entrance Test in the Notice of Provisionally Selected Candidates and Admission to be uploaded in the website by 27.07.2018.
- (b) The Entrance Test shall be held for 100 marks and the Duration shall be of 2 (two) hours.
- (c) The concerned Department/ Centre for Studies shall conduct the Entrance Test for selection of candidates to the relevant programme. The pattern of the questions of the Entrance test shall be decided by the Department/ Centre for Studies concerned.

6. Admission Procedure:

- a) The notice of Provisionally Selected candidates and the date of admission (for 80% of the seats) to be uploaded in the website by 27.07.2018 with due approval from the Authority.
- b) The List of the candidates for the 20% of the seats selected through the Entrance Test shall be notified by 07.08.2018 along with the Admission Schedule.

- c) The candidates provisionally selected for Admission (under any category) shall have to bring the following documents on the date of admission:
 - i) A print copy of the online application submitted along with photocopies of all relevant testimonials.
 - ii) All original documents for producing before the admission committee
 - iii) The Admission Fee, Course Fee, Hostel Admission fee, etc. (as per the Fee Structure is given in the website).

The Admission Fee, Course Fee, Hostel Admission fee, etc. to be paid by the candidates at the time of admission through online mode by using their Debit Card/Credit Card or internet banking.

- iv) Hostel admission form if needed (downloadable from the website).
- v) The Admission of the candidates shall be held in the respective Departments/ Centres for Studies on the scheduled dates only.

7. Waiver of Admission Fee (as per the Office Memorandum of the Government of Assam):

The candidates claiming waiver of their admission fees as per the Office Memorandum issued by the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam vide Memo No.PC/HE/SOPD/02/2017/44 dated 28.05.2018 shall have to comply with all the relevant conditions and will be needed to submit the requisite documents before the Admission Committee on the date of Admission for consideration of fee waiver. NOTIFICATION

Standardization of Marks for admissions into the Post Graduate Programmes for the Session 2018-2019

This is to notify that as per the existing policy for admission into the various academic programmes of Dibrugarh University, 80% of the total seats in each subject of the MA/M.Sc./ M.Com Programmes shall be filled up by the eligible candidates graduated from the affiliated/ permitted/ autonomous colleges/ Institutes of Dibrugarh University for the session 2018-2019. The candidates for these seats shall be selected on *Merit Basis* of the qualifying examination concerned.

Further, in pursuance of the Notification vide Ref: DU/DCE (A)/ Standardization/2017/18 dated 24.07.2017 regarding Standardization of Marks for admission into Post Graduate programmes of Dibrugarh University, 2017-2018, following policy shall be followed for standardization of the marks secured by the Candidates of the affiliated colleges and autonomous college (North Lakhimpur College) of Dibrugarh University-

To standardize the marks secured by the Candidates, the Z-Scores for both the affiliated colleges and autonomous college (North Lakhimpur College) is computed as below:

$Z=(X-\mu)/\sigma$

where X is the secured score (percentage) by a particular applicant of a particular subject with mean percentage μ and standard deviation σ . Since the Z- score for some applicants may come out as negative, so the merit list may be expressed in terms of a standard score.

Standard Score=**Mean** (**Standard Population**) +**s**.**d**. (**Standard Population**) ***Z** (Ref.: Statistics for Psychology and Education, Author: H. E. Garret, Publisher: Longmans, Green & Co.)

The Mean and Standard Deviation of the raw marks of the Candidates of the affiliated colleges and autonomous college (North Lakhimpur College) for the session 2018-2019 shall be notified after declaration of the Final Semester result.

However, taking into consideration the interest of the students of the North Lakhimpur College (Autonomous), the University has decided to create *one supernumerary seat* in each teaching programme, where the number of candidates selected for admission from the North Lakhimpur College (Autonomous) is less than two. This policy was also adopted in the academic session 2017-2018. Issued with due approval.
