Online applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission into the MCA & BCA Programmes for the Academic Session 2018-2019.

**Six Semesters Master of Computer Application (MCA) Programme:**

**Eligibility for Admission:**

Graduate in any discipline with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks having Mathematics as one of the subjects in 10+2, wherein pass mark is a must. Candidate appearing in Bachelor's Degree final examination whose results awaiting to be declared may also apply. Such candidates have to complete the Bachelor degree before the end semester examination of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester. Relaxation of 5% marks will be given to the candidates of reserved categories.

**Admission Procedure:**

Candidates will have to appear in the MCA Entrance Test to be held on **23<sup>rd</sup> of June, 2018** from **11.00 AM** at the following Centers:

- Centre for Computer Studies, Dibrugarh University
- NERIM, Guwahati
- J.B. College, Jorhat

Candidates qualifying the entrance shall be admitted to the programme solely from the merit list prepared from the entrance results provided that the eligibility criteria prescribed above are fulfilled.

**Pattern of the Entrance Test:**

**Note:**

- i) The question paper will be of multiple choice type.
- ii) There will be no negative marks for wrong answers.
- iii) The question paper will be set in English language only.

**B. Six Semester Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) Programme :**

**Eligibility for Admission:**

Candidates having passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examination securing minimum of 45% marks in aggregate with Mathematics / Commercial Arithmetic / Statistics as one of the subjects in 10+2, wherein pass mark is a must. Such candidates have to complete the 10+2 before the end semester examination of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester. Relaxation of 5% marks will be given to the candidates of reserved categories.

**Admission Procedure:**

Candidates eligible for admission shall be selected on merit basis. The merit list will be displayed at the office of Centre for Computer Studies, D.U. and in the websites: [www.dibru.ac.in](http://www.dibru.ac.in) and [www.ccsdu.in](http://www.ccsdu.in) on **29<sup>th</sup> June, 2018.**

**How to apply:**

The intending candidates need to apply online through the “Online Application Submission” portal of Dibrugarh University which is available at [www.dibru.online](http://www.dibru.online) from **29.05.2018**. The application fee of **Rs. 500/-** needs to be paid at the time of applying online through Debit Card/ Credit Card/ Internet Banking. On successful submission of the Application, an Acknowledgement Slip with “SUCCESS” status will be generated. Candidates are advised to

download and print the Acknowledgement Slip along with the submitted Application Form and Admit Card for future reference. A step-by-step instruction of the Application Process is available on the homepage of the “Online Application Submission” portal.

**Important Note:** The University shall not verify the eligibility of a candidate at the time of receiving their Application Forms and Issuing Admit Card to them for the MCA Entrance Test. The candidates not fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria shall not be debarred from appearing the MCA Entrance Test, 2018. However, the candidate who clears the entrance shall not be considered at the time of admission to the MCA/BCA Programme conducted by Dibrugarh University and its affiliated colleges if he / she fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria. Hence, the intending candidates are requested to ensure themselves regarding fulfillment of the minimum eligibility for admission into the MCA/BCA Programme.
