The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dibrugarh University is pleased to approve the following modifications in the Modified Regulations for the Three Year Master of Computer Applications (MCA) Programme (Non-CBCS) under report to the Post Graduate Board and the Academic Council, Dibrugarh University with immediate effect:

Admission Eligibility criteria for admission Graduates of Dibrugarh University or any other University recognized by Dibrugarh University under 10+2+3 (TDC) pattern of Degree course in Arts/Science/Commerce with 50% marks in Graduation and passing Mathematics as one of the subjects in 10+2 or in Degree level or BCA Degree Holder A candidate must be aged between 20 to 26 years as on the date of admission. Relaxation of marks and age shall be as per the rules of the Government of Assam.</p>	<p>2. Admission Eligibility criteria for admission <u>For Regular Entry:</u> Graduates in any discipline with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks having Mathematics as one of the subjects in 10+2 or at graduation level, wherein pass mark is must. Candidates appearing in Bachelor's Degree final examination whose results awaiting to be declared may also apply with an undertaking that he / she will be completing the Bachelor's Degree on or before the conclusion of 1st Semester. Relaxation of 5% marks will be given to the candidates of reserved categories. <u>For Lateral Entry:</u> Students who have completed Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years duration in BCA, B .Sc.(IT / Computer Science) with Mathematics as a course at 10+2 level or at Graduate level shall be eligible for admission to second year MCA courses up to a maximum of 20% of sanctioned intake plus unfilled vacancies of 1st year which shall be over and above, supernumerary of the sanctioned intake. Note: Candidates will be required to qualify in the Entrance Test conducted for M.C.A. Lateral Entry Admission Test (MCALEAT). In no case, candidates not appearing in MCALEAT will be eligible for lateral entry. Candidates must also fulfill the conditions regarding age as per rules formulated by the university / government from time to time. Relaxation for scheduled caste / scheduled tribes / other backward classes (including MOBC) candidates shall be as per existing rules of the state government.</p>
