REVISED ADMISSION NOTICE FOR THE POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN COUNSELLING PSYCHOLOGY (PGDCP) PROGRAMME ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-2020

The Centre for Studies in Behavioural Sciences (CSBS) invites Online applications from interested eligible candidates for Admission into the **PG Diploma in Counselling Psychology (PGDCP) Programme**(s) for the Academic Session **2019-2020**. The PG Diploma Programme is of one year's duration and consists of 2 (two) Semesters.

How to apply:

The intending candidates need to apply online through the "Online Application Submission" portal of Dibrugarh University which is available at www.dibru.online from 25.07.2019. The application fee of Rs. 500/- needs to be paid at the time of applying online through Debit Card/ Credit Card/ Internet Banking. On successful submission of the Application, an Acknowledgement Slip with "SUCCESS" status will be generated. Candidates are advised to download and print the Acknowledgement Slip along with the submitted Application Form and Admit Card for future reference. A step-by-step instruction of the Application Process is available on the homepage of the "Online Application Submission" portal.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission

For PG Diploma in Counselling Psychology (PGDCP): Post Graduate Degree in any discipline from a recognized University.

Desirable:

- Candidates must have a Post graduate degree with Specialization in subjects like Psychology, Human Development and Family Studies, Child Development, Human Development and Childhood Studies, Child Development and Family Relationships, Home Science, Social Work, Medicine or other allied disciplines. "Allied disciplines" include Anthropology, Sociology, Education, Philosophy, MBBS or Nursing from a recognized University.
- Working Professionals with 2 or more years of relevant work experience in the social section and people-oriented professions such as Psychology, Social Work, Education, Health and Law and Human Resource Management.
- Candidates should have at least 50% marks at the Master's level to be eligible for admission to the Post Graduate Diploma in Counseling Psychology (PGDCP) Programme.
- There will be a relaxation of 5% marks for candidates from the SC/ST/OBC categories.

 Reservation of seats in the PGDCP shall be as per the specified norms of Dibrugarh University.

Method of Selection

• Admission for the PG Diploma in Counseling Psychology (PGDCP) Programme, will be based on an Interview and Viva of the applicants to the Programme, who will be provisionally selected on the basis of their PG level marks for the Interview at the Centre on a notified date in the 1st week of August 2019. Final List of selected candidates will be notified on the basis of the composite score of their PG level marks and the score obtained in the Interview in the Admission Notification of selected candidates in the last week of the month of July 2019.

Admission Procedure

PG Diploma in Counselling Psychology (PGDCP): Provisionally selected candidates will be invited for an Interview and Viva on an appointed date, in the first week of August 2019. The date of the Interview will be notified both in the Centre's Notice Board as well as the DU website.

Selected students shall have to bring the following documents in original along with a Self attested Xerox copy of all the testimonials at the time of Interview:

- i) HSLC Admit Card
- ii) All relevant Mark-sheets (HSLC, HS, Degree & Master's of all semesters)
- iii) Pass certificates (HSLC, HS, Degree, Master's Degree)
- iv) Degree/ Master's Degree Registration Card
- v) Character Certificate from the institute last attended.
- *vi)* Caste Certificate (if selected under reserved category)
- vii) Permanent Residency Certificate (PRC)
- viii) No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the appropriate authority/employer (if employed) for attending the Programme.
- ix) Print copy of the **Online Application Form** submitted by the applicant.

NB

In case a candidate intending to apply for the PGDCP Programme of the CSBS, has an academic gap of above two years, a Gap Certificate or Affidavit, shall have to be provided by the concerned applicant citing legitimate reasons for the break in studies.

1. Online Registration will start from -25th July 2019

2. Last date for submission of online application - -31st July 2019 (up to 5.00 PM)

3. Notification of provisionally selected candidates -2nd August 2019

4. Date of Admission - - - - - - -5th August 2019

*** No personal intimation will be made to the selected candidates. Notification of Provisionally Selected Candidates will be displayed <u>only</u> in the Notice Board of the Centre for Studies in Behavioural Sciences (CSBS) and also in the University's Official website.
