

Distribution of Flood Relief Materials



The Key Resource Centre (KRC) of Dibrugarh University (DU) as part of its social responsibility for the common masses, distributed essential materials to the victims of the flood affected areas through Dibrugarh University Post Graduate Students Union (DUPGSU). The purpose of the humanitarian aspect of KRC was assistance of those in need.

The essential items distributed included cartons of Biscuits - 40 Nos ; Sanitary Napkin - 40 Nos; Mosquito Coils - 40 Nos; Dettol Soaps -40 Nos ; and Phenyl Bottles - 25 Nos. Apart from the packets of biscuits, the other items were given for people to maintain good and hygienic health conditions as prevention from illnesses and water borne diseases. Besides these, old cloths were also given to the villagers.

The Nodal officer of Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) DU, Dr. Shukla Acharjee , handed over the items to the General Secretary of DUPGSU, Rahul Chetri at the office premises of KRC , on Aug'13, 2019.
