



8.9(c)	<i>At least 50% of the Core Courses shall be evaluated by the examiners other than the course teachers recommended by the Departmental/Centre CBCS Board. 9.3	<i>A candidate who fails or does not appear in one more courses of any end semester examinations up to the final Semester shall be provisionally promoted to the next semester with the failed course(s) as carry over course(s).
